Royton Hall proposed consultation

Consultation on a reduction to the Published Admission Number (PAN) at Royton Hall Primary School from 60 to 45 with effect from admissions to the school in September 2023.

The consultation period will run for four weeks from 1 December 2021 until 12 January 2022. The Local Authority working with the School's Governing Body will give very careful consideration to all comments received during the consultation period before reaching a decision on whether or not to proceed with the proposed changes.

What change is being proposed?

Royton Hall Primary School was extended to a PAN of 60 from 45 to support the completion of local housing developments from September 2020. However, the further housing developments have not proceeded in the numbers expected and is not expected to for a number of years. As a result, the LA's long-term projections for school places now indicate the demand in the locality will not sustain the increased PAN.

To support the school in their staffing and financial planning the Local Authority working with Governing Body of Royton Hall Primary School is, therefore, proposing to reduce the PAN for the school from 60 to 45. This proposal will return the school back to its original PAN from pre-September 2020.

The proposed change would be implemented from September 2023 and start with the Reception intake only. The change will move through the school year by year.
