Statement:	Positive Responses	
1. My child is happy at this school	98%	We are pleased that your child is happy coming to our school and we will continue to do our best to ensure this is our priority.
2. My child feels safe at this school	98%	We take safeguarding seriously and welcome your views and ideas on this too. 'Safeguarding is everyone's responsibility.'
3. My child makes good progress at this school	96%	We recognise that not all parents can be available on specific parents evenings so please contact the school if you wish to discuss your child's progress with the class teacher.
4. My child is well looked after at this school	98%	All staff do their best to ensure your child is looked after and this includes a range of support e.g. if they feel unwell, they need prescribed medication, support with lunch. We have First Aid trained members of staff and we work to support your child's emotional health.
5. My child is taught well at this school	99%	We are happy that you feel your child is taught well and that you have good relations with your child's teacher. We continue to strive to improve our teaching through training and development of staff.
6. My child receives appropriate homework for their age.	93%	We constantly try to get the balance right for homework. We appreciate that some parents have less time than others so we stick to the basics of reading, spelling, multiplication tables.
7. The school ensures the pupils are well behaved	95%	We reward good behaviour with praise, stickers, points, and awards in assembly. We follow a system called 'Good to be Green' which runs on the premise of traffic light cards. The school rules are written with a positive slant and are visible in all classes. The 'Citizen of the Week' is rewarded every Friday. We regularly receive compliments from external visitors about the good behaviour of our children.
8. This school deals effectively with bullying	94%	We have skilled staff who work with children on specific aspects of emotional challenges, behaviour and managing feelings. We always try to be fair and any kind of exclusion would be a very last resort.
9. The school is well led and managed	96%	Everyone in school leads on an important aspect to help the school run smoothly. This includes all aspects of curriculum, finance and health & safety to name a few. We aim to have consistency across all areas. All staff are trained regularly in line with their responsibilities.
10. This school responds well to any concerns I raise	96%	Your class teacher meets the children every morning in the playground. If you have concerns you can see them there. If you need more time or wish to see the headteacher then please do make an appointment at the office. Tel: 0161 770 1529
11. I receive valuable information from the school about my child's progress	95%	We provide a written report to parents twice per year and a parents evening twice per year. A newsletter from your child's Key Stage is sent every term. Teachers are available for meetings before and after school by appointment.
