In October 2018 we asked you to comment on the following statements. We had 165 responses (from 70 last year) which is fantastic!

Statement:	YES	
 My child is happy at this school. 	98%	We are pleased that your child is happy coming to our school and we will continue to do our best to ensure this is our priority.
 My child feels safe at this school. 	99%	1% said they didn't know. We take safeguarding seriously and welcome your views and ideas on this too. 'Safeguarding is everyone's responsibility.'
 My child makes good progress at this school. 	95%	2% said they didn't know. We recognise that not all parents can be available on specific parents evenings so please contact the school if you wish to discuss your child's progress with the class teacher.
 My child is well looked after at this school. 	98%	1% said they didn't know. All staff do their best to ensure your child is looked after and this includes a range of support e.g. if they feel unwell, they need prescribed medication, support with lunch. We have more than 20 members of staff trained at First Aid.
 My child is taught well at this school. 	95%	3% said they didn't know. We are happy that you feel your child is taught well and that you have good relations with your child's teacher. We continue to strive to improve our teaching through training and development of staff. Please see our SATs results 2018
6. My child receives appropriate homework for their age.	85%%	10% said they didn't know. We constantly try to get the balance right for homework. We appreciate that some parents have less time than others so we stick to the basics of reading, spelling, multiplication tables and a half-termly project.
7. The school ensures the pupils are well behaved.	93%	4% said they didn't know. We reward good behaviour with praise, stickers, points, and awards in assembly. We follow a system called 'Good to be Green' which runs on the premise of traffic light cards. The school rules are written with a positive slant and are visible in all classes. The 'Citizen of the Week' is rewarded every Friday. We regularly receive compliments from external visitors about the behaviour of our children.
8. This school deals effectively with bullying.	58%	30% said they didn't know. We have skilled staff who work with children on specific aspects of emotional challenges, behaviour and managing feelings. We always try to be fair and any kind of exclusion would be a very last resort.
9. The school is well led and managed.	88%	 9% said they didn't know. Everyone in school leads on an important aspect to help the school run smoothly. This includes all aspects of curriculum, finance and health & safety to name a few. We aim to have consistency across all areas. All staff are trained regularly in line with their responsibilities.
10. This school responds well to any concerns I raise.	82%	12% said they didn't know. Your class teacher meets the children every morning in the playground. If you have concerns, you can see the teacher there. If you need more time or wish to see the headteacher then please do make an appointment at the office. Tel: 0161 770 1529
11. I receive valuable information from the school about my child's progress.	92%	5% said they didn't know. We provide a written report to parents twice per year and a parents evening twice per year. A newsletter from your child's Key Stage is sent every term. Teachers are available for meetings before and after school by appointment.
