### **Key Stage 1**

This term in Key Stage 1, our topic is Take Off Around the World. Each week we will travel around the world exploring a different continent and the surrounding oceans. We will develop our writing skills using our segmenting finger, full stops, fingers spaces and capital letters. We will be developing our writing across all of the curriculum subject areas as we journey around the world. We will become artists as we design and make African inspired prints and historians as we find out about the lives of Dr Martin Luther King Jr, Captain Scott and Felicity Aston. In Maths we are learning about place value, addition and subtraction and developing our fluency in Mastery Maths. We will become scientists as we explore habitats and food chains.
