1. Is your child happy at this school?	97%	We aim for all of our children to be happy in school and offer a broad curriculum, a safe environment and opportunity for extracurricular activity.
2. Does your child feel safe at this school?	97%	'Safeguarding is everyone's responsibility.' We regularly update our safeguarding training and procedures. Children are encouraged to tell a trusted adult if they have a problem. We regularly practice Fire Drill and In-Vac procedures as well as teach pupils how to stay safe in the environment and how to keep themselves safe online.
3. Does the school make sure its pupils are well behaved?	88%	We use a 'Good to be Green' system in school for behaviour which your child should be familiar with. We focus on positives and praise. For more challenging elements we work with parents and other agencies where appropriate.
4. Is your child well looked after at this school?	97%	All staff do their best to ensure your child is looked after and this includes a range of support such as if they feel unwell, they need prescribed medication, support with their lunch, their friendships or anxieties. We have several members of staff trained in First Aid and two trained in Mental First Aid. We also work with the Mental Health Support Team in Oldham.
5. Does the school respond well to any concerns you raise?	91%	We try to respond to all concerns and resolve any issues, where possible, as soon as they are raised. 6. Is your child encouraged to work hard and do their best?	98%	We are thrilled that you recognise that we encourage all of our children to do their best. We use 'green spots' to encourage pupils to work towards their bronze, silver and gold awards for good work as well as rewarding our Learners of the Week and Citizen of the Week in the Friday Assembly.
7. Does the school communicate well with parents	90%	We communicate with parents by email, text, phone call, letter, our website and Facebook. We try to keep parents up to date with all events and regularly send out flyers and links to other events and / or agencies across Oldham. We use 'Marvellous Me' to let parents know of any awards their child has earned and Early Years use 'Tapestry.' We also invite parents to the Friday Assembly if their child has been nominated.
8. Is your child taught well at this school?	98%	We are thrilled that you recognise how well your child is taught at this school. We are fortunate to have very experienced and dedicated staff.
9. Is the school well led and managed?	92%	The school is managed by a range of leaders across all subjects and all Key Stages. This also includes Financial Management to ensure your children have the teachers and resources they need for learning. Our Governors manage at a strategic level.
10. Would you recommend this school to others?	94%	We are grateful for all your positive recommendations and thank you for supporting our school.
