1. Is your child happy at this school?	100%			We strive to ensure every child feels happy and secure at school. Our broad curriculum, caring environment and wide range of extracurricular opportunities are designed to help children thrive academically and personally.
2. Does your child feel safe at this school?	100%			Safeguarding is everyone's responsibility. Our staff regularly update their safeguarding training and procedures. Children are encouraged to speak to a trusted adult about any concerns. We also practise Fire Drills and In-Vac procedures and teach pupils how to stay safe both in the real world and online.
3. Does the school make sure its pupils are well behaved?	89%	10%	1%	We use the 'Good to be Green' behaviour system, which celebrates positive choices and encourages reflection when needed. We focus on praise and reward, working closely with parents and external agencies where extra support is appropriate.

Is your child well looked after at this school?	96%	4%		Our staff are dedicated to supporting every child's wellbeing, whether they're feeling unwell, need help with friendships or experience anxiety. Many of our staff are trained in First Aid and our Pastoral Team includes Mental Health First Aiders. We also work closely with the Oldham Mental Health Support Team.
