Mrs Charlton's News

In this week's Key Stage 2 assembly, we explored the theme of 'Who Are You Online?'. Children discussed how their digital behaviour helps shape their online identity and influences how others perceive them. We also considered how what we say, share and do online can have an impact on others. The assembly reinforced the importance of staying safe online and highlighted practical ways we can all help to keep ourselves and others safe in the digital world.

It has been a busy week of assessments for our Year 1 and Year 4 children, and we are incredibly proud of the determination, resilience and positive attitude shown by every child throughout the testing process.

On Wednesday, our Year 1 children completed their Phonics Screening Check. There were some challenging real and alien words to read, but Miss Finn, Miss Barry and Miss Muff were all extremely impressed with the children's efforts and achievements. Also this week, our Year 4 children took part in the Multiplication Tables Check, where they had just six seconds to answer each of 25 multiplication questions. Mrs Moore and Mrs Sidell were full of praise for the focus, perseverance and excellent attitudes demonstrated by all of the children. Next week, children in Years 1 to 5 will complete their end-of-year assessments, providing an opportunity to celebrate the progress they have made throughout this academic year.

Yesterday, Mr Charnock, Mrs Oakley (one of our school Governors), and I had the pleasure of listening to our Year 5 pupils present their applications for the role of Head Pupil for the next academic year. Twenty one children applied for these positions, and the standard of presentations was exceptionally high. Each candidate spoke with confidence, enthusiasm, and maturity, making the selection process incredibly difficult. With only four positions available, choosing the successful candidates was no easy task.

The successful applicants have now been selected and will be informed later today. However, on behalf of everyone involved in the process, I would like to express how proud we are of every child who applied. Each pupil demonstrated courage, determination, and a willingness to step outside their comfort zone. They were all outstanding and are a real credit to themselves, their families and our school.
